

## Improving Outreach & Engagement What we've been hearing thus far

#### **Challenges:**

- Many still don't understand or are unprepared to engage
- Worried about how they'll be affected; some much more affected than others
- Everyone's busy or limited on resources
- Unclear about meaningful involvement
- Fear/confusion → trust issues
- Balance b/w responding to concerns and staying on topic

#### **Opportunities**:

- Lots to build off from
- New interest since Plan development
- New/improved resources and contacts
- New partners and support (e.g., CAC, O&E Team)
- Joint fact-finding
- MANY lessons learned



#### Issues of Interest

#### **Projects & Implementation**

- When projects break ground and how long it will take before we see positive results in Cosumnes
- The focus in the GSP on government-affiliated projects; skepticism about large agencies having the Basin's best interest at heart

#### **Viability and Cost**

- Wells running dry and associated costs
- How much will GSP Implementation cost and who pays?

#### **Dealing with Uncertainty**

Depending on science that is difficult to understand





## Issues of Interest (continued)

#### **Equitable, Transparent, Informed, Collaborative Process**

- Will those that need help, get that help? (Enough water, compensation, etc.)
- How issues are considered, discussed, and decided upon
- How to ensure informed dialogue on accurate information
- How to problem solve together in efficient and effective manner

#### **Outreach and Engagement**

- How to bring in the hard-to-reach voices
- How public feedback is considered and incorporated
- Ensuring every groundwater user in the basin knows about the GSP



## Selected O&E Suggestions

- Provide information in advance with sufficient time to prepare
  - Digest the material, ask questions, vet ideas
- Ensure consistent, transparent, and authentic messaging
  - Empower your messengers (committee members, partners, GSAs, etc.)
- Improve how we meaningfully consider and respond to suggestions and feedback; document accordingly (why it is or isn't incorporated)
- Pique interest by drawing connections to issues of highest concern
  - Encourage responses to outreach by emphasizing that fees may be involved
