Workshops

Staff are preparing to hold another round of workshops in November. In addition to inviting a variety of partner organizations (GSAs, other local agencies, etc.), CGA would prepare information on groundwater conditions and project status, like our February/March events.

- Morning, Saturday, November 4, 2023 from 10am 12pm Wilton Community Center

The O & E Workshop Ad Hoc Committee discussed/brainstormed possible poster ideas and topics:

- 1. Funding broken down financials, fee structure, how the money is being used, the fees, etc. (almost like a non-profit pie chart breakdown)
- 2. Upcoming/current projects and/or recent activities such as the helicopter ride and what it showed/uncovered
- 3. Ideas for the future things we want to do or haven't been able to yet and why what is needed and why
- 4. Water knowledge information about the basin, the Cosumnes river, pipeline, wells, bring it back to the basics and keep it simple, etc.
- 5. Cosumnes 101 History of the Groundwater Authority as well as the subbasin
- 6. Update on well levels after monitoring can we get this information in time for the workshop?
- 7. Comparing where we are now to where we were in the basin show the changes via pictures and statistics. Does EKI have this information?
- 8. Resources where people can go for more information, assistance, maps with GPS coordinates
- 9. Water Quality drinking water, having your well tested once a year, domestic well user 101
- 10. What the water issues mean for local flora/fauna the fish and water levels and how it affects local communities.



WHO IS THE **COSUMNES GROUNDWATER AUTHORITY?**



>>> A BRIEF HISTORY OF CGA

The Cosumnes Groundwater Authority was formed in November of 2021 by seven Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs):

- Amador County Groundwater Management Authority
- Clay Water District
- · City of Galt
- · Galt Irrigation District
- Omuchumne-Hartnell Water District
- County of Sacramento
- Sloughhouse Resource Conservation District

CGA strives to be a hub of information regarding Groundwater Sustainability within the Cosumnes Subbasin, while implementing the Cosumnes Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP). The Cosumnes GSP was adopted in January of 2022 and it aims to assess groundwater quality, surface water depletion, land subsidence and other sustainability indicators while also proposing measures to correct any "undesirable results".

With the assistance of our technical consultants at EKI Environment & Water, Inc., CGA is continuing to assess the quality and quantity of groundwater in the subbasin and strategize to reverse any deficits and ensure long-term sustainability of the water available to businesses, residences, farms, ranches and ecosystems.

8 WAYS TO PROTECT AND CONSERVE GROUNDWATER

>>> REDUCE USAGE AND POLLUTION

- 1. **Dispose of chemicals properly** and reduce the use of chemicals or toxic substances such as paint, motor oil, fertilizer sprays, etc.
- 2. **Fix the leak** Check all faucets and taps in your home for any possible leaks. One leaky faucet can waste more than 3,000 gallons of water per year!
- 3. **Limit water usage** take shorter showers, turn off the tap while brushing your teeth, and only run the dishwasher and laundry when doing full loads.
- 4. **Go native** utilizing native plants in your landscape such as succulents, sagebrush, yucca, lavender, etc. reduces the need for extensive watering.

- 5. **Annual well inspection** maintain your well to ensure it is running properly, constructed correctly, free of pollutants and bacteria, and receive an assessment of your water supply levels.
- 6. **Follow state regulations following rain** California regulations prohibit watering landscapes with potable water within 48 hours after measurable rain.
- 7. **Use natural alternatives** invest in natural or nontoxic household cleaners, fertilizers or other materials to limit any pollution or chemical runoff.
- 8. **Get involved** learn more about water education and local groundwater conditions by attending a Cosumnes Groundwater Authority meeting!
